

THE FUTURE OF THE MOBILE COMMUNICATIONS BY SATELLITE Cantabria University 2007 Summer courses

Madrid, 27th June 2007 - As every year Thales Alenia Space España will participate in the 2007 Summer courses that annually celebrate the international university of Cantabria, in this occasion from 9 to 13 of July 2007 in Santander - Spain.

With the title: The future of the mobile communications by satellite, the objective of the course pursuit the study of today and future mobile communication services and systems through communications satellite.

The course will be focussed on the new systems known as "SATCOM the move" to provide mobile multimedia broadcast services (Mobile TV, digital radio...) directly onto user terminals.
